ORDER

For the ongoing Centrally Sponsored Scheme – National Food Security Mission – Government of India has released a total fund of Rs.3436.70 lakh in second instalment for the year 2009-10, out of which Rs.1703.68 lakh is meant for NFSM-Rice and Rs.476.63 lakh for NFSM-Wheat and Rs.1256.39 lakh for NFSM-Pulses.

In the light of the above release the undersigned is directed by order of the Governor to say that the Governor is pleased to reallocate a total amount of Rs.3016.63 lakh as per Annexure enclosed herewith. While an amount of Rs.420.07 lakh is kept at the State Headquarter for further release and use. The total amount of Rs.3016.63 lakh is allocated district wise in favour of concerned Deputy Director of Agriculture (Administration) & the Project Director, ATMA i.e. District Level Agency for NFSM. The fund hence released should be utilized as per guidelines of Government of India and the physical target set up by the Director of Agriculture, West Bengal. The total fund of Rs.3016.63 will be released from the account of West Bengal State Food Security Agency.

There should be no deviation from the Work Plan duly approved by the Government of India. Utilization Certificate and Progress Report in respect of the release are to be submitted by the Concerned D.D.A. (Administration) to the West Bengal State Food Security Agency with intimation to this Department and the Director of Agriculture, West Bengal.
