Sub : According Administrative approval and sanction of fund for execution of the Scheme "Soil Conservation works in Wasteland and Agricultural Lands on Watershed basis in Plains & Hills" under State Plan during the financial year, 2009-2010.

In continuation of this Deptt.'s G. O. N. 582-Dev.(SC), dated 05.11.2009 alongwith the Director of Agriculture, Government of West Bengal's Memo No. 642, dated 24.08.2009, the undersigned is directed by order of the Governor to say that the Governor has been pleased to sanction and release fund amounting to Rs. 10 Lakh (Rupees Ten Lakh) only which is remaining 25% of the approved ~~amount~~ cost for the execution of soil and water conservation works as per enclosed Statement 'A' under the scheme "Soil Conservation Works in Wasteland and Agricultural Lands in Watershed basis in Plains and Hills" under State Plan during the financial year, 2009-2010.

2. The expenditure will be met from the head of account, "2402-00-789-Special Component Plan for SC-SP-State Plan (Annual Plan & 11th Plan)-001-Scheme for Extension of Soil Conservation Works on Wasteland and Agricultural Lands on Watershed basis in Plains & Hills-(AG)-27-Minor Works/Maintenance" under Demand No. '5' and Departmental Code "AG" during the current Financial year.

3. The Governor has further been pleased to place the entire amount i.e. Rs. 10 Lakh sanctioned above at the disposal of the Director of Agriculture, West Bengal.

4. The Assistant Director of Agriculture (Admn.), Soil Conservation (DPAP) of Jhargram/Purulia/Bankura will act as the Drawing & Disbursing Officer in respect of the expenditure sanctioned for the purpose subject to allotment/sub-allotment of fund by the Director of Agriculture, West Bengal.

5. Expenditure shall be incurred on full satisfaction of the Director of Agriculture, West Bengal about admissibility, accuracy and justification of the expenditure and due observation of the financial rules and norms.

6. Allotment received and expenditure incurred shall be reconciled with the entries in the books of Accounts of the Accountant General, West Bengal at the end of the financial year.

7. Utilisation Certificate shall be sent within ninety days of drawal of the amount.

8. This order issues in concurrence of Finance Deptt., Group-'N' vide their U.O. No. 2817, dated 08.03.2010.
